CEDP Trust has provided "English Speaking and Soft Skills" training to underprivileged children and youth of World Vision India's project at Mumbai. The duration of the course was of 2 months and all the course material costs were borne by CEDP Trust. CEDP Trust conducted sessions across Marol, Asalfa, Ghatkoper, Powai, Dharavi and Sion and total 148 students were benefited. The course included certificates, demo and video lectures, notes, business communication sessions, tips on honing interview skills, grooming tips, resume making and life skill training. CEDP Trust along with the World Vision gave these underprivileged children and youth an opportunity that will help them to move ahead not just in terms of education but also explore their latent talents.
